Muddy Creek Meadows Summer Day Camps

Horse Camp provides the perfect opportunity for boys and girls to learn the fundamentals of riding and horse care. From the beginner rider to the more advanced, children grow during their sessions, gaining confidence, independence, and leadership skills.

Each session includes campers riding for at least 2 hours daily. They will learn horsemanship through activities such as grooming, tacking, first aid, hoof care, nutrition, and anatomy. Campers will learn how to care for their horses by participating in daily chores such as mucking stalls, cleaning tack, and feeding. Campers will also enjoy games, even games on horseback, crafts and an afternoon swim. Even work on some vaulting skills to enhance balance. English and Western riding offered. No riding experience necessary. All riding levels welcome.

Lunch— Bring a bagged lunch. Drinks will be provided.

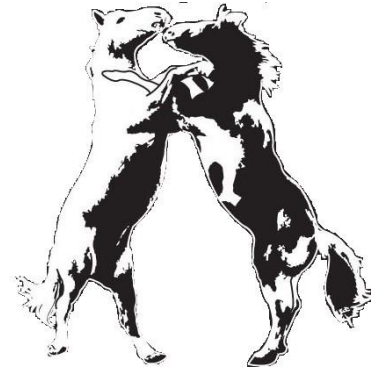
Swim wear-Bathing suit/swimming trunks, Towel, sunscreen, Sandals or Flip flops (May be worn to and from the pool only.)
